The safety of our students is my number one concern. In the recent months, there have been a couple of close calls with student safety in the Bus Drop Off/Pick Up Zone. We are limited with our options with our current construction of our lot.

Effective April 2nd, we are going to implement something NEW. ONLY school vehicles (bus or van) allowed in the loading/unloading zone. Parent vehicles must use the parking lot and school patrol crosswalk to drop off students.

The anticipated time frame of this is 7:40-7:55 AM and 2:40-2:55 PM. During this time, ONLY school vehicles will be allowed in the loading/unloading zone.
